The Product

Securitas uses Wave's EMBASSY® Remote Administration Server (ERAS) for centralized administration of self-encrypting drives (SEDs), including management of users, logon credentials and access rights to the drives.

Self-encrypting drives perform encryption in the drive controller itself, meaning encryption takes place independent of a laptop's computing power and operating system. This offers added protection against hackers and counteracts the system performance issues often associated with software-only encryption solutions.

ERAS provides comprehensive remote management of SEDs, including secure audit logs that enable companies to conform to internal company policies and to comply with international data privacy and data security regulations such as ISO/IEC 27002.
